

Riverside Landing Boat Rentals

Welcome to the Old Mill Stream. A public boat livery concession is available for rental of canoes, kayaks and pedal boats in Riverside Park. Canoes and kayaks may also be taken by renter via car top carrier to other river or locations within Hancock County with advance reservation.

Equipment Rates

Canoes/Kayaks/Pedal Boats - \$5 / craft / 1/2 hr
Canoe & Kayak Float Trips - \$25 / craft / daily
Group Float Trip (6 or more) - \$20 / craft
All rates include life jackets, paddles and sales tax. Driver's license required for float trips.

Rental Information

1. Rentals for groups and float trips must be arranged in advance at HPD Office.
2. Life jackets and paddles are outfitted according to size and number in party.
3. Group discounts apply when renting 6 or more watercrafts for at least 1 hr. Not available during normal rental times.
4. Call HPD office for further rental information.

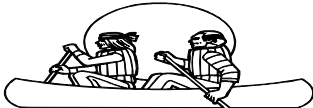
Seasonal Operation

Boat livery operations are weekends and holidays, late May through mid-September. Rentals closed during periods of high water or hazardous weather. No rentals after dark.

Hours

Weekends and Holidays 1 to 7 pm
Other times by special arrangement
Last launch time for 1 hour rentals is 6 pm
& 6:30 pm for 1/2 hour rentals

Float Trips (by reservation only)

Groups and individuals can reserve a canoe/kayak float trip on the Blanchard River or other Hancock County waterways in advance at the HPD Office. Complete outfit includes life jackets and paddles. Car-top carriers are provided to transport on their own vehicle. Renting 6 or more, HPD will provide transportation. A driver's license must be provided when reservation is made.

Watercraft Safety Rules

1. Operators must be at least 12 yrs of age unless accompanied by adult (18 or older).
2. Pedal boats must stay within old reservoir. Canoes and kayaks can not go beyond S.R. 568 bridge (Sandusky St.).
3. All watercraft must stay away from waterfalls (dam) and not cross safety line. Watch out for water hazards and stay clear of orange safety markers.
4. Unsafe operation, ramming, or splashing will not be tolerated and terminate rental use without refund determined by waterfront staff.
5. Life jackets must be worn at all times.
6. Remain seated in watercraft at all times. Canoes and kayaks may be temporarily docked at Eastpoint or Waterfalls Landing only. Do not trespass on private property.
7. Maximum capacity of boats:
Pedal Boats - 2-4 persons depending on weight
Canoes - 2 adults w/ 1 - 2 children or 3 youths
Kayaks - 2 adults or 1 adult w/ 1 child
Weight limit determined by HPD staff
8. Canoeists through Country Club Golf Course are cautioned to beware of flying golf balls.
9. No littering! No food or beverages in boats.
